### **JUDGMENT**

Sri Samarth Sridhar for M/s Shetty & Hegde Associates, learned counsel appearing for appellant, submits that due to financial constraint appellant could not make statutory deposit.

In spite of granting sufficient time, appellant has failed to make statutory deposit and comply with the proviso to Section 43(5) of the RERA Act, which is mandatory in case of appeal by developer.

Hence, appeal is dismissed for non-compliance of proviso to Section 43(5) of the Act.
