ವಿಷಯ Regarding Execution of Order.

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| 8 | <p>A complaint under Section 31 of RERA Act has been initiated by the complainant Mr. Sushil Kumar Bansal who is the customer under the project "The Green Phase I" which is developed by "Sanchaya Land And Estate Pvt. Ltd.,". This complaint was filed by the complainant claiming refund of money along with interest and compensation as the developer has failed to complete the project on time. After hearing the parties order was passed on 17/11/2018 directing the developer to return amount of Rs. 34,52,398 within one month, if not it will carry interest @10.25%.</p> <p>As on date the developer has not made any attempt to honour the order dated 17/11/2018 and hence, the complainant has given a representation on 13/03/2019 to this authority to take action against the developer for recovery of the ordered amount.</p> <p>On the basis of the representation, notice was issued to the developer to appear before Adjudicating Officer through E-Mail on 29/03/2019 but none were present on behalf of the developer. Again notice was issued to appear on 15/04/2019, even on that day none represented. Hence matter was posted for orders.</p> <p>As per Rule 25 of the Karnataka Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Rules, 2017 the recovery of the amount due is to be considered as arrears of land revenue. In support of the same the authority is taking the shelter under Section 40 of the RERA Act which reads as follows;</p> |



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Sec 40(1): "if a promoter or an allottee of a real estate agent, as the case may be, fails to pay any interest or penalty or compensation imposed on him, by the adjudicating officer or the regulatory authority or the appellate authority, as the case may be, under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under, it shall be recoverable from such promoter or allottee or real estate agent, in such manner as may be prescribed as an arrears of land revenue"

When Sec. 40 read with Rule 25, the Deputy Commissioner is empowered to execute the order dated 17/11/2018 considering this amount as arrears of land revenue and has to be recovered from the developer. Hence the following order:

ORDER

By acting under Section 40 of the RERA Act, read with Rule 25, the amount payable of Rs. 35,78,434/- to the complainant is treated as arrears of land revenue from Sanchaya Lands and Estate Pvt. Ltd., and the same has to be recovered by sending the file to Deputy Commissioner for recovery as arrears of land revenue. The same amount shall be recovered and deposit to the account of the Authority.
