This Appeal is filed under Section 44 of the Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Act, 2016 before the Tribunal to set aside the order dated 17.10.2022 in CMP/200724/0007284 passed by the Authority, RERA Respondent No.2.

This appeal coming on for orders this day, the Chairman, made the following:

#### **JUDGMENT**

The appellant, who is a promoter of a real estate project known as "PRESTIGE TEMPLE BELLS" situated in Hoskerehalli village, Uttarahalli Hobli, Bangalore, has preferred this appeal challenging the impugned order dated 17<sup>th</sup> October, 20-22 passed in complaint No. CMP/200724/ 0007284 directing the promoter to allot car parking space to the complainants as agreed without demanding additional amount from them.

- 2. Today, a Joint Memo signed by the Authorised Signatory of the appellant, learned counsel for the appellant, Respondents 1(a) & (b) and learned counsel appearing for them is filed stating that the appellant and Respondents 1(a) & (b) have got their dispute pertaining to complaint No. CMP/200724/0007284 and this appeal settled out of court and pray the Tribunal to dispose of the appeal as settled out of court. The Joint Memo is taken on record.
- 3. Accordingly, for the reasons stated in the joint memo, we pass the following:

#### ORDER

- (i) Appeal is dismissed as settled out of court;
- (ii) In view of dismissal of the Appeal, all pending I.As.if any, stand rejected, as they do not survive for consideration;
- (iii) The Registry shall comply with the provisions of Section 44 (4) of the Act and return the records to RERA, if any.
