JUDGMENT / ORDER

1. FACTS OF THE CASE: The Complainant vide complaint No. CMP/200423/0005837 filed under section 31 of the Act has sought the following reliefs:

- i) Direct the respondent/s to refund all the money together with delay period interest on the entire money paid by the Complainant from the promised date of delivery until handing over possession along with Occupancy Certificate.
- ii) Compensation for mental agony and pay the damages to an extent of Rs.5,00,000/-.
- iii) Compensation for unfair trade practice to an extent of Rs.5,00,000/-.
- iv) Cost of litigation and expenses to an extent of Rs.50,000/-.
- 2. The Advocate for complainant has filed a Memo dated 06.07.2022 before the Authority for withdrawal of the complaint. In the said memo it is stated that the complainant may be permitted to withdraw the aforesaid complaint in order to file a complaint before Consumer Commission so as to seek the refund of the money and other applicable reliefs. Hence, the Authority passes the following order.

ORDER

The memo submitted by the Advocate for Complainant for withdrawal of the complaint is taken on record and complaint is treated as dismissed.
