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Complaint under Section 31 of RERA Act has been initiated by the complainant Zubin who is the consumer under the project "Nitesh Cape Cod Phase 1" which is developed by "Nitesh Urban Development Pvt. Ltd.," This complaint was filed by the complainant claiming for refund. After hearing the parties, order was passed on 28/02/2020 The developer hereby directed to return Rs. 95,73,558/- to the complainant. The developer is hereby directed to pay simple interest @ 9% P.A from the date of payment till 30/04/2017 and @ 2% above the MCLR of commencing from 01/05/2017 realisation. (MCLR be calculated the rate which prevailed as on today) The developer is also directed to pay Rs. $5{,}000/-$ as cost of this petition.

The complainant has given a representation on 03/06/2020 to this authority to take action against the developer for recovery of the said amount since the developer failed to comply with the order.

On the basis of the representation, notice was issued to the developer calling for his objections through online to submit before 15/06/2020 on account of maintaining social distance as per SOP of this authority dated 04.06.2020. According to notice the developer has not submitted his reply Therefore, the matter was posted for orders.

	When Sec. 40 read with Rule 25, the Deputy Commissioner is empowered to execute the order dated 28/02/2020 considering this amount as arrears of land revenue and has to be recovered from the developer. Hence the following order:-
